Brief Description:

A K-9 Kiddo youth volunteer assists with dog socialization and exercise, preparing dogs for adoption and integration into their new homes. Volunteer may assist with walking approved dogs, playing with approved dogs in the friendship yard, brushing and grooming of approved dogs, and fence feeding approved dogs. Volunteer must be comfortable with dogs and have basic knowledge of K-9 handling and care.

Responsibilities:

- Meet Mission & Vision of Tulsa SPCA.
- Comply with all Tulsa SPCA policies and procedures, including a high standard of dependability for promptness and attendance.
- Assist with socialization and exercise of approved dogs.
- Assist with the preparing dogs for adoption and integration into new homes.
- Completing other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Must be at least 9 years of age.
- Must have parent or guardian with them during all volunteer shifts if under the age of 16.
- Must be comfortable around dogs and have basic knowledge of K-9 handling and care.
- If youth volunteer is 13 years of age or younger, they may only interact with dogs 6 months or younger.
- Must complete Dog 101.
