Brief Description:

Mini MACkers are volunteers that assist with Mobile Adoption Center outings around the community. Volunteers are responsible for pet care and handling during events, pet showing and socialization, maintaining cleanliness and sanitization of the MAC, and providing information to the general public about the Tulsa SPCA. Mini MACkers must be comfortable with both dogs and cats, and have the ability to react appropriately to stressful situations.

Responsibilities:

- Meet Mission & Vision of Tulsa SPCA.
- Comply with all Tulsa SPCA policies and procedures, including a high standard of dependability for promptness and attendance.
- Assist with socialization and exercise of approved dogs.
- Assist with showing of dogs on MAC events.
- Assist with set up, tear down, and cleaning of the MAC.
- Provide information and answer questions of the general public.
- Completing other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Must be at least 9 years of age.
- Must have parent or guardian with them during all volunteer shifts if under the age of 16.
- Must be comfortable around dogs and have basic knowledge of K-9 handling and care.

- Must have ability react appropriately to non-socialized dogs or stressful situations.
- If youth volunteer is 13 years of age or younger, they may only interact with dogs 6 months or younger.
- Must complete Dog 101 and MAC training.
